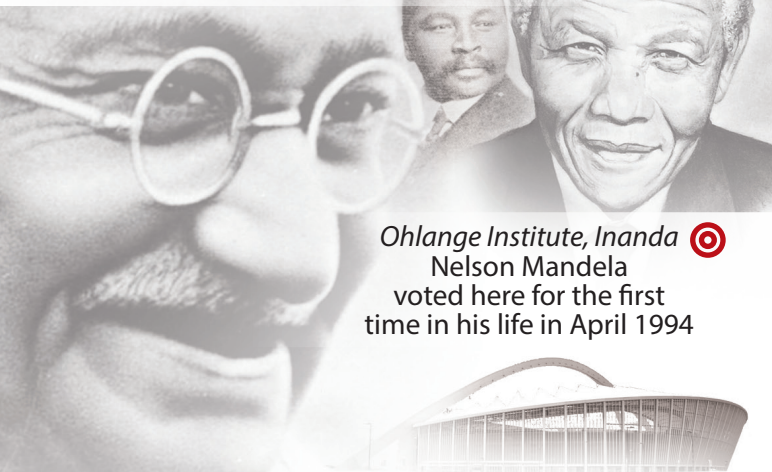

- The Inner City – Durban Harbour, the Victoria Market, business district and central Durban.
- Inanda Seminary – the oldest girls’ boarding school in Southern Africa, established in 1869 by the American missionaries
